

Neoterrex Minerals drilling Valour Project, Quebec

Neoterrex Resources Inc. (TSXV: NTX) has commenced a 1,500-meter maiden drill program at its Valour project, located in the highly prospective Abitibi geological subprovince of Quebec, Canada. The project is situated 60 kilometers northwest of Waswanipi and adjacent to Kenorland Minerals' Chebistuan property, which is currently under an exploration agreement with Newmont Corp.

The drill program will target magnetic bodies that exhibit strong electromagnetic responses and anomalous copper mineralization. The project area is characterized by favorable geological attributes, including volcanic and sedimentary rock units, a major unconformity, and a significant fold axis.
