

Sembcorp Secures Landmark Solar Plus Storage Project in India

Sembcorp Industries, a leading global energy, urban, and marine solutions provider, has secured a significant milestone in its renewable energy portfolio. The company's Indian subsidiary, Sembcorp Green Infra Private Limited, has been awarded a 150 megawatt solar photovoltaic project coupled with a 300 megawatt-hour battery energy storage system (BESS).
