A core component of the system is SRT's proprietary AI-driven intelligence, which will deliver critical insights into maritime activities such as illegal fishing, smuggling, and maritime safety violations. Furthermore, the system will feature a national marine data integration platform, designed to interconnect all relevant national marine agencies for a unified operational picture.

Under the terms of the agreement, SRT will deploy multiple command centers, strategic multi-sensor coastal surveillance towers, long-range drones, and integrate surveillance capabilities into patrol vessels. This initiative underscores the growing global demand for advanced maritime domain awareness solutions.
