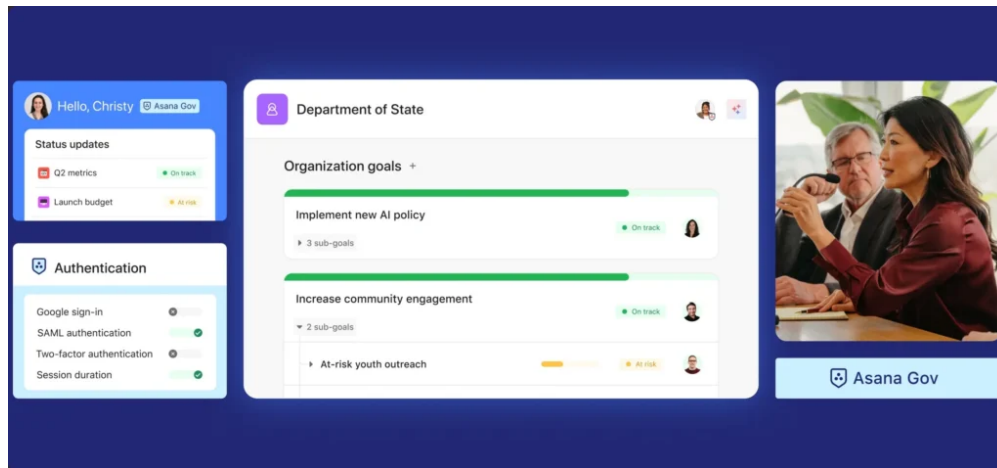


Asana launches FedRAMP-in-process platform to support secure, mission-critical government work

Asana, Inc. has introduced Asana Gov, a FedRAMP-in-process work management platform designed to help government agencies, regulated industries and public sector partners plan and execute mission-critical work with clarity, speed and security. The platform combines Asana’s Work Graph® technology with controls that meet stringent federal security and compliance requirements.

Many government organisations still rely on siloed systems, manual processes and legacy tools that slow execution and complicate collaboration. Asana Gov is intended to address these challenges by connecting teams, tools and mission objectives within a single secure workspace, enabling more coordinated and accountable delivery.

Built for organisations managing multiple programmes and departments, Asana Gov maps who is responsible for what, by when and why, giving agencies a clear, connected view of progress and ownership across initiatives. This enables teams to link work directly to strategic goals, coordinate cross-department workflows, and respond quickly to shifting priorities through real-time dashboards and AI-powered insights.

Agencies can begin with a single workflow and scale adoption across programmes as needs evolve.
