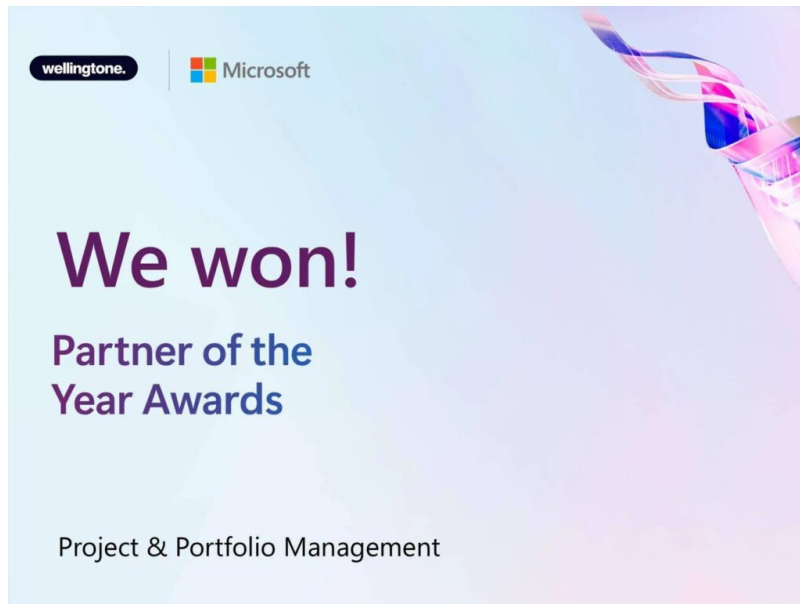


Wellington wins global 2025 Microsoft Partner of the Year Award for Project and Portfolio Management
